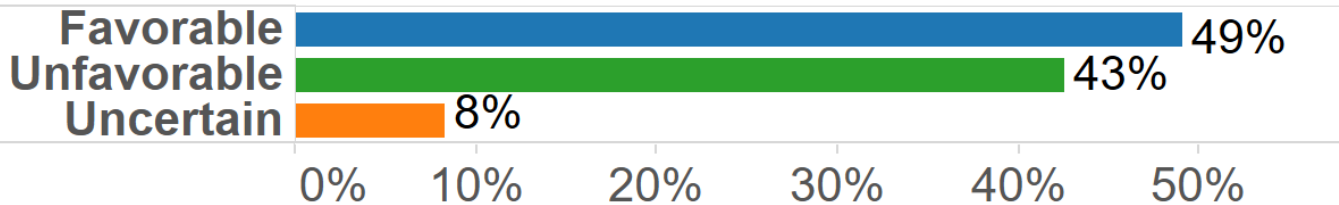

Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 911 likely voters in Pennsylvania’s 18th Congressional District. The poll was conducted from March 1st through the 5th and has a margin of error of ±3.3%. The totals may not round to 100% because of rounding. The survey was conducted using interactive voice responses and an online panel of cell phone users. The results are weighted by voting demographics.

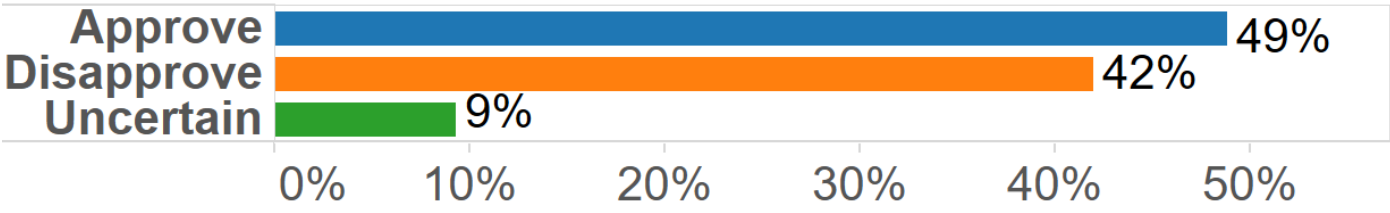

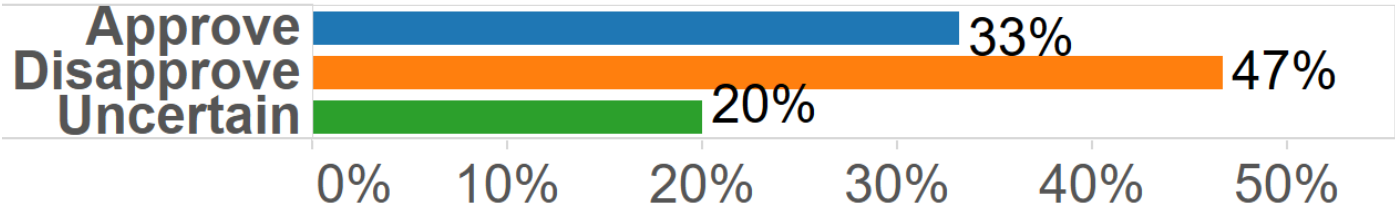

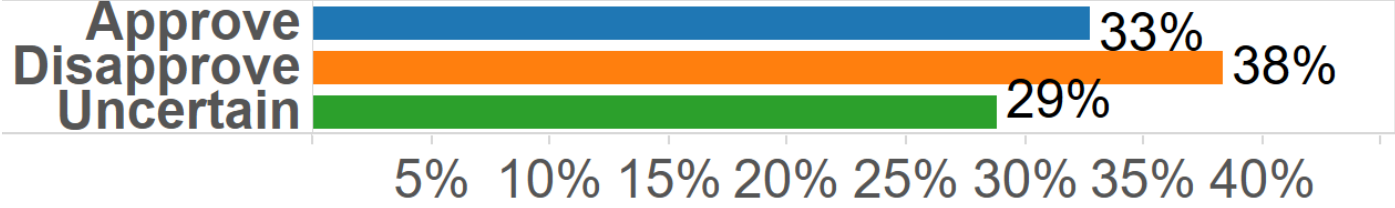

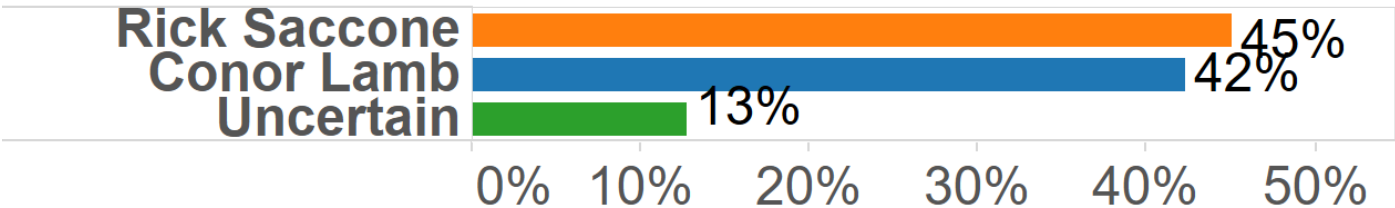

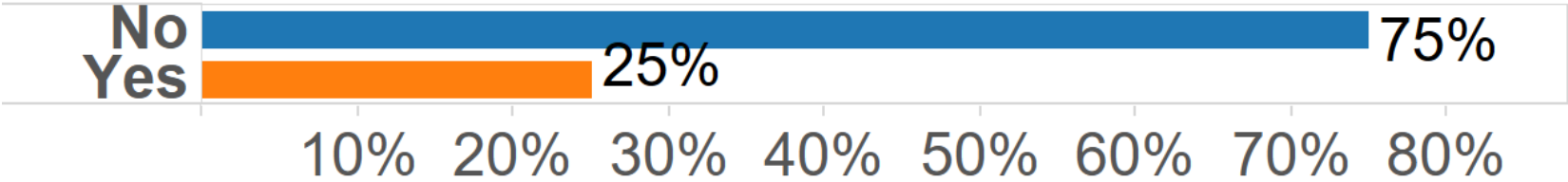

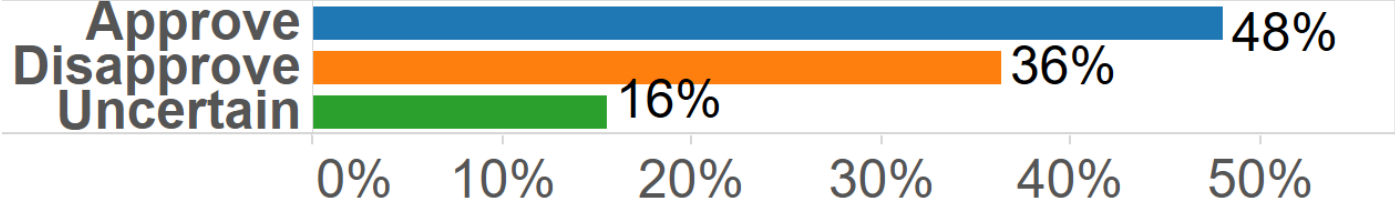

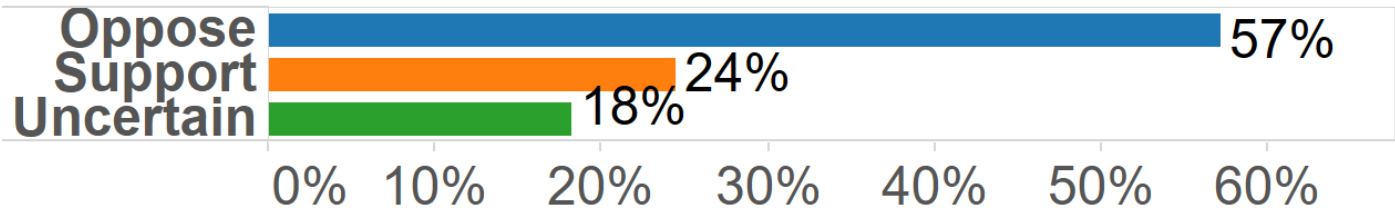

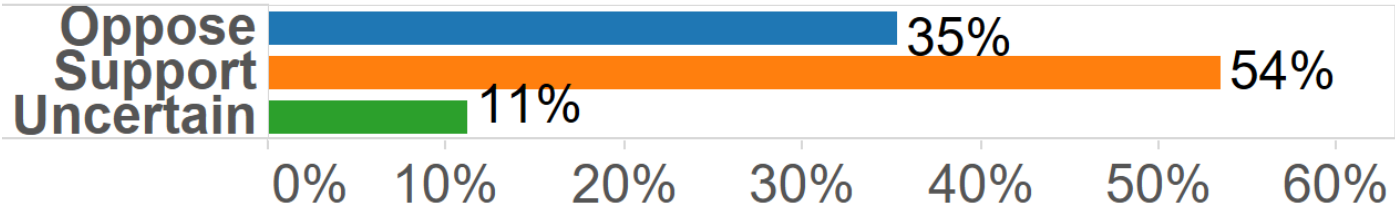

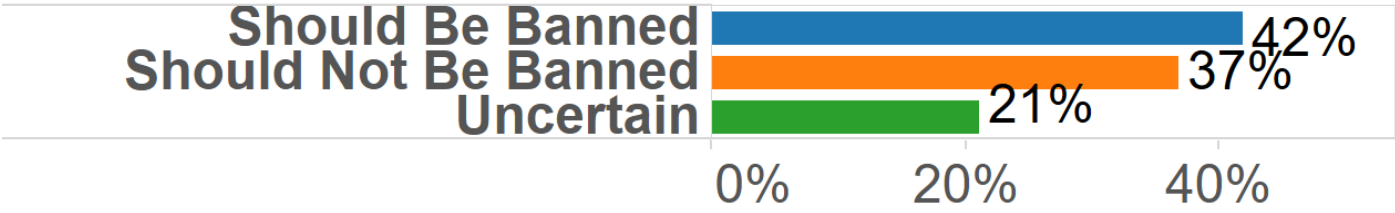

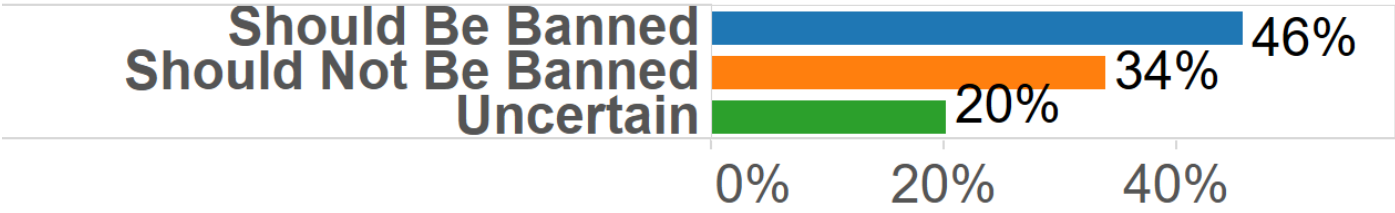

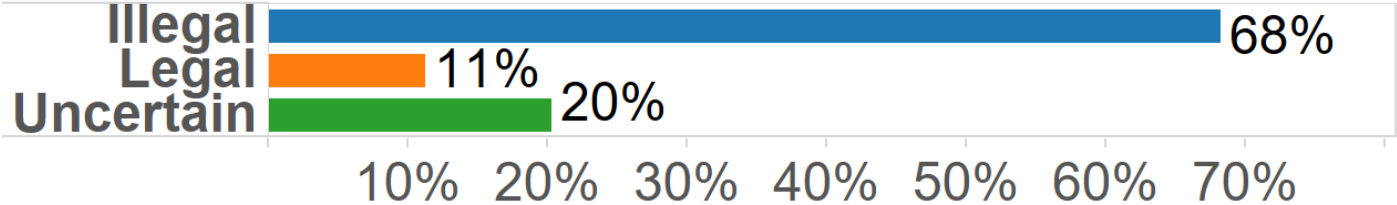

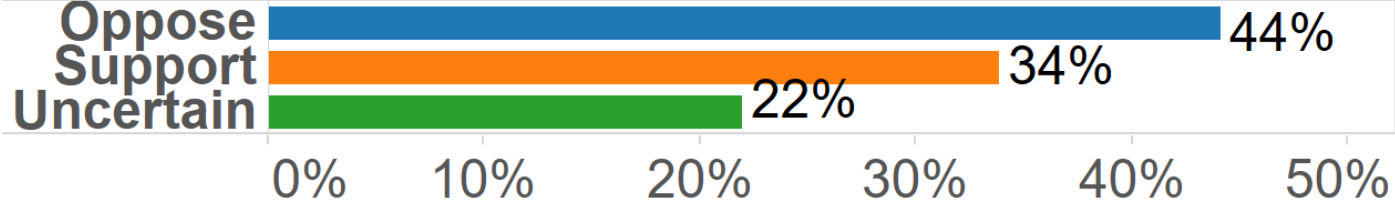

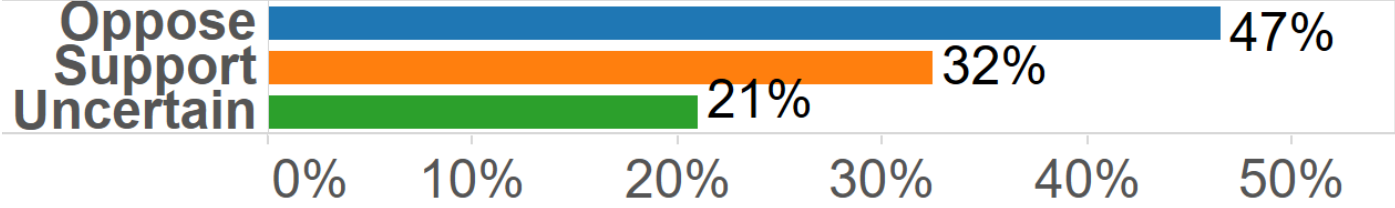

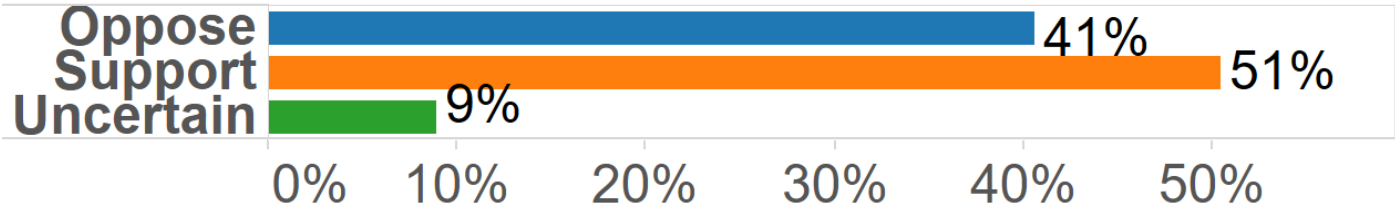

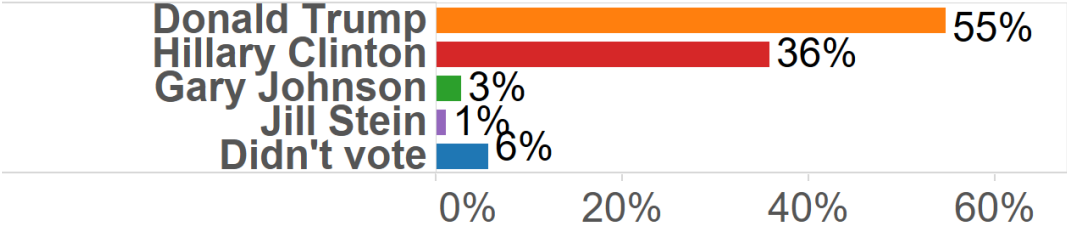

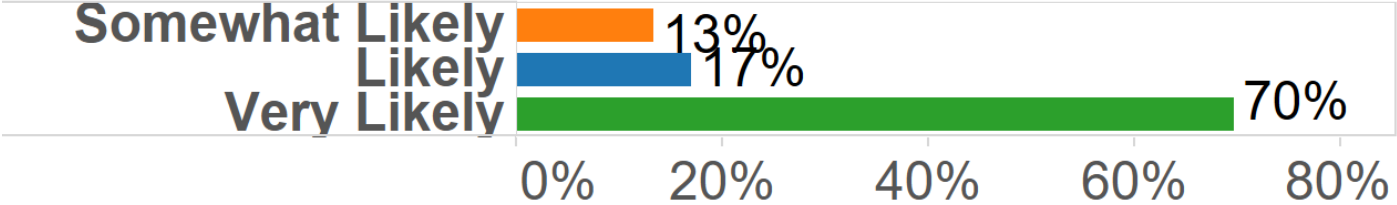

Q2: LIKELIHOOD

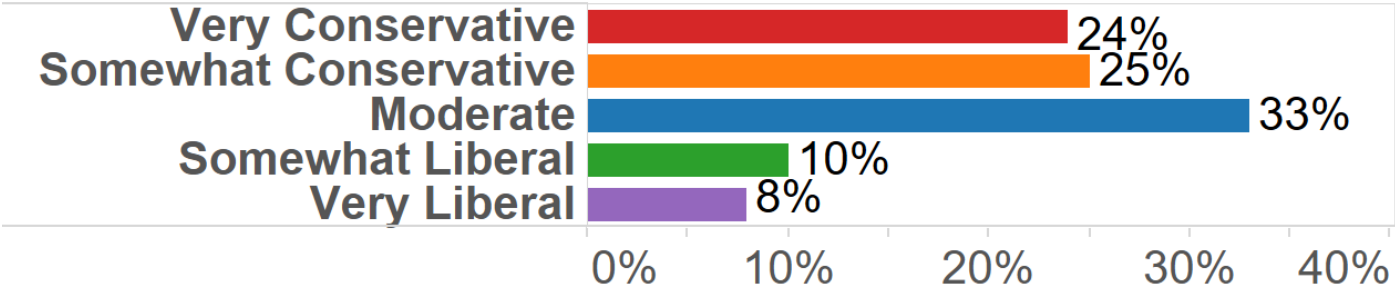

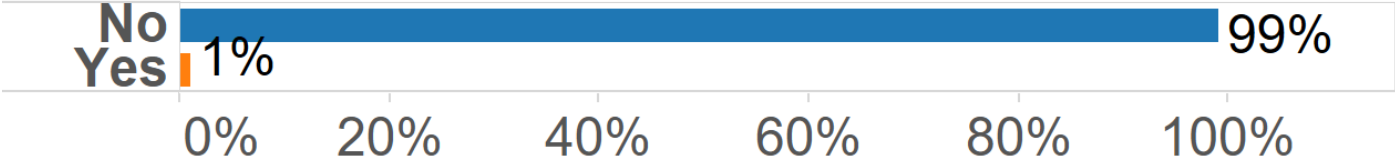
20) What is your political ideology?

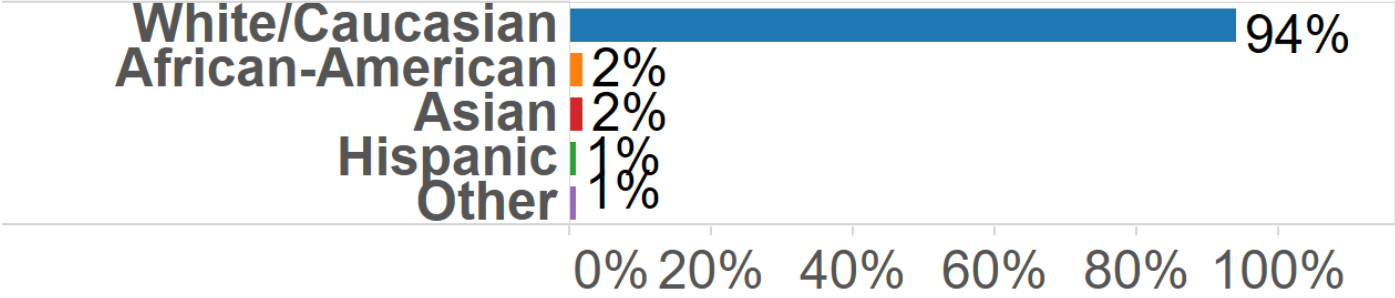
21) Are you or is a member of your immediate family from a Latino, Hispanic or Spanish speaking background?

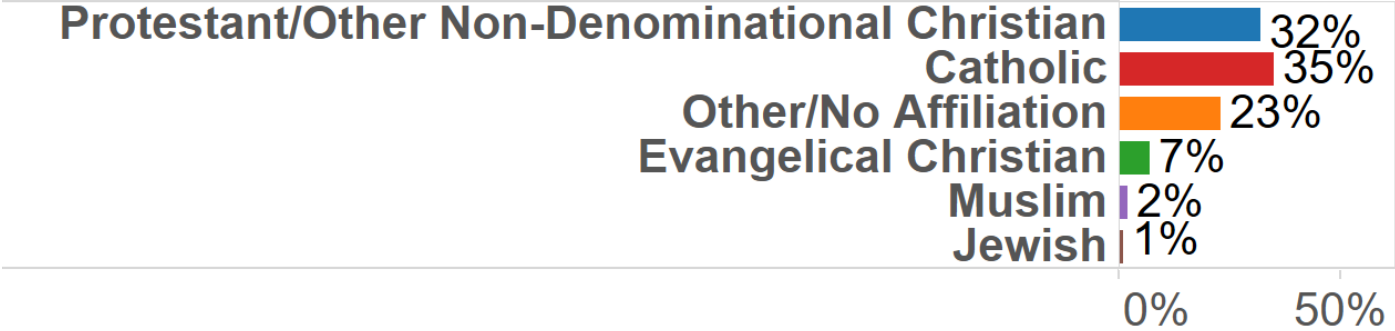

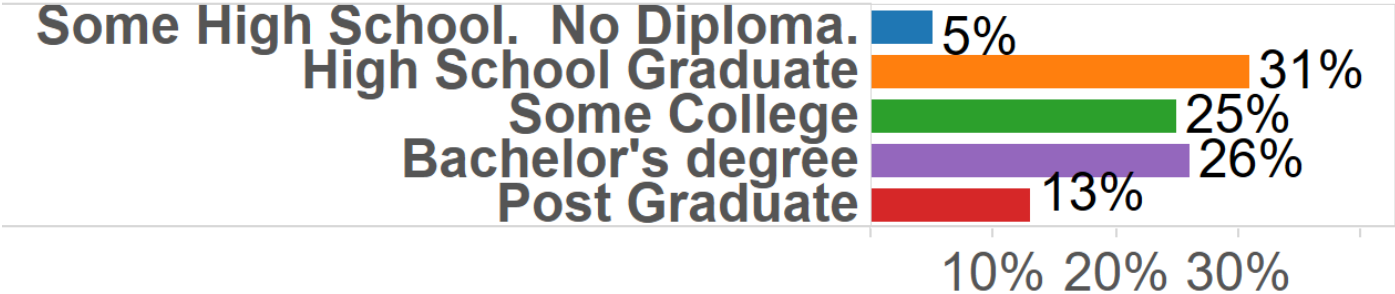
23) Which of the following best represents your religious affiliation?

Religious affiliation



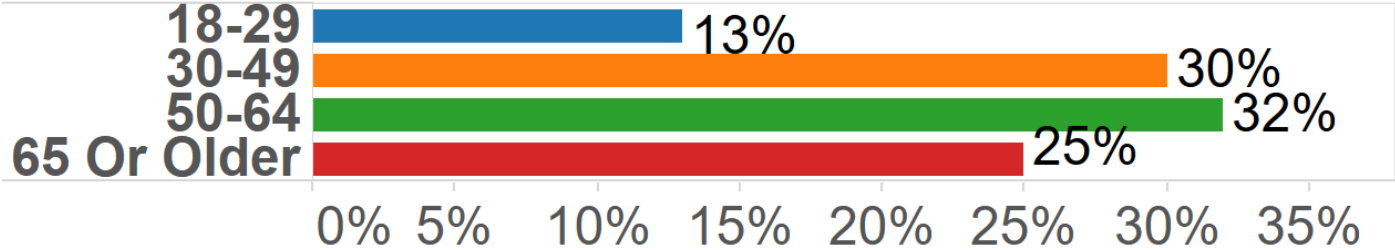
24) What is the highest level of education you have completed?
