

# Tennessee Polling

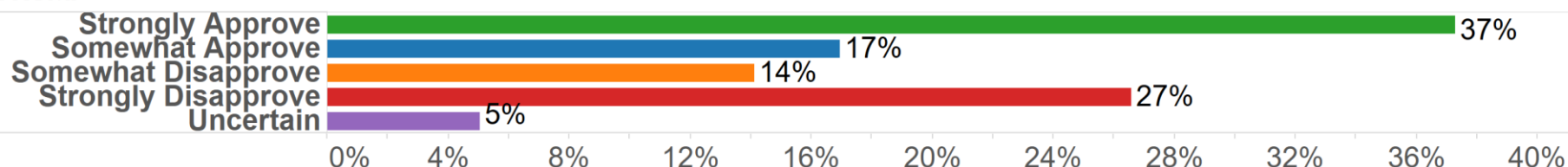

## Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 620 likely voters across Tennessee. The poll was conducted from August 9<sup>th</sup> through the 11<sup>th</sup> and has a margin of error of  $\pm 3.9\%$ . The totals may not round to 100% because of rounding. The survey was conducted using an online panel of cell phone users and interactive voice responses. The results are weighted by voting demographics. The poll was paid for by Gravis Marketing.

**3) Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of President Trump's job performance?**

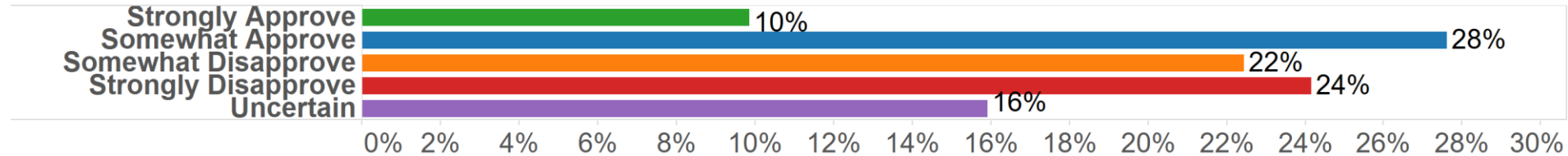

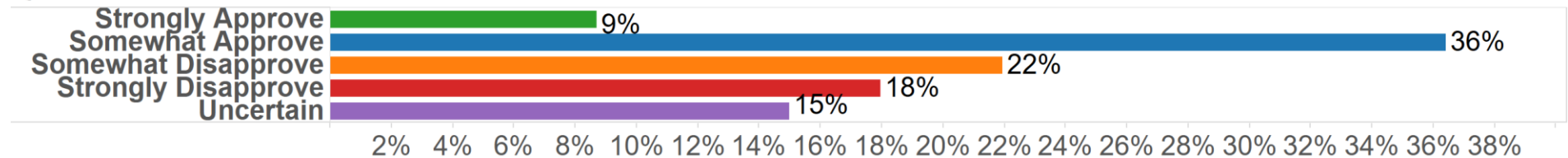

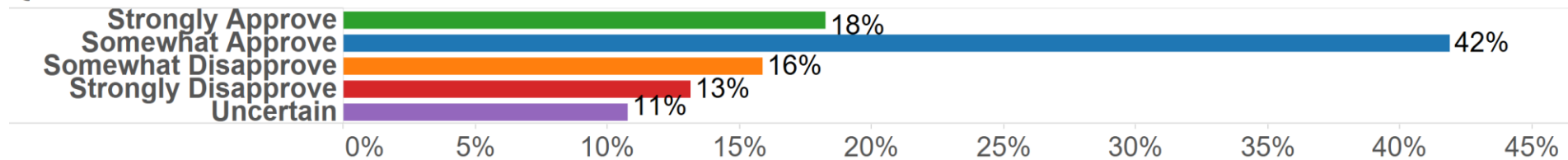

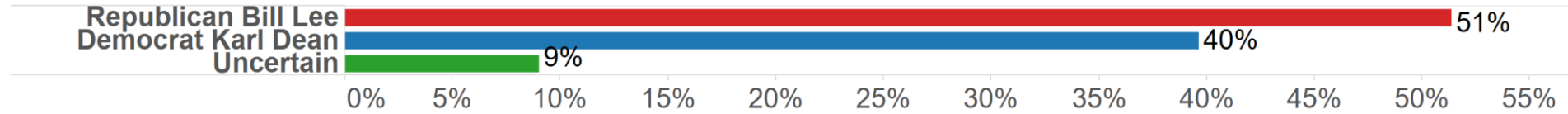

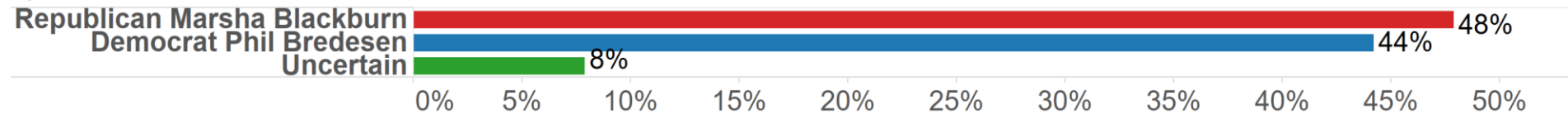

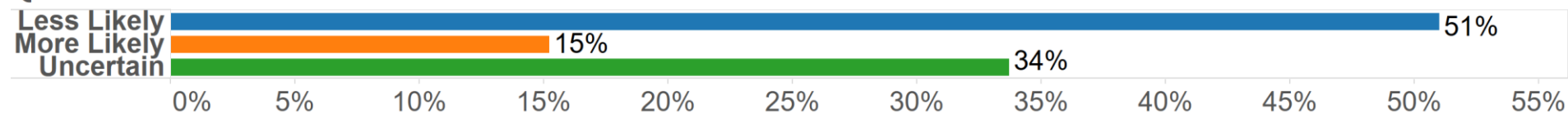

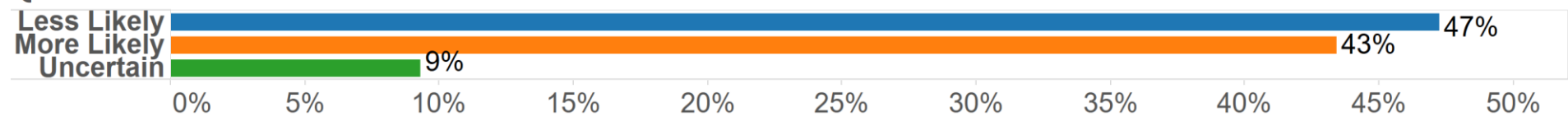

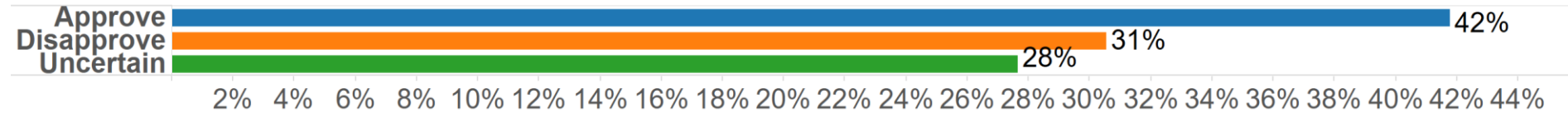

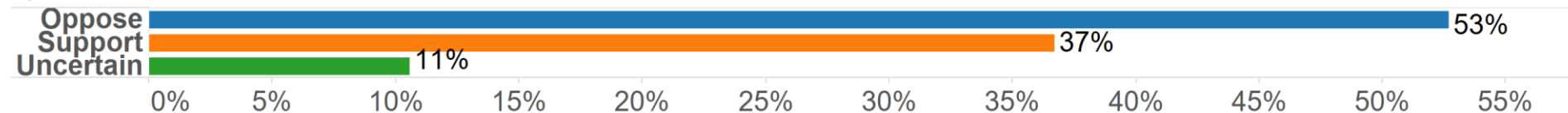

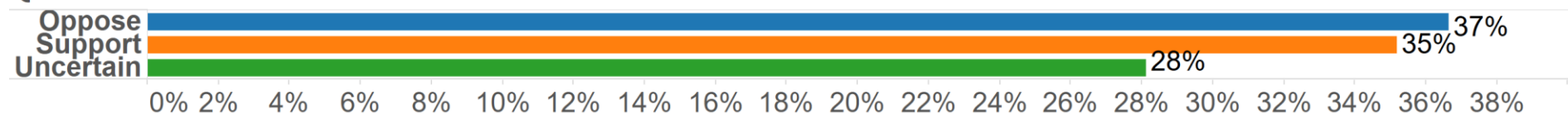

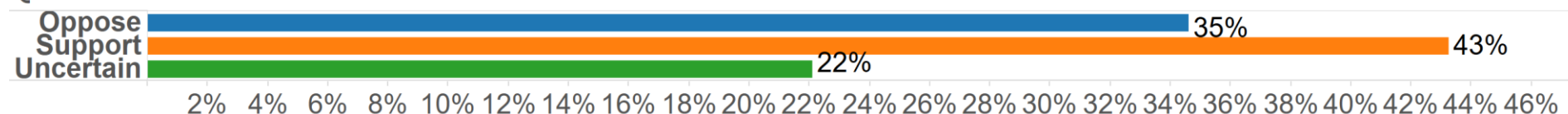

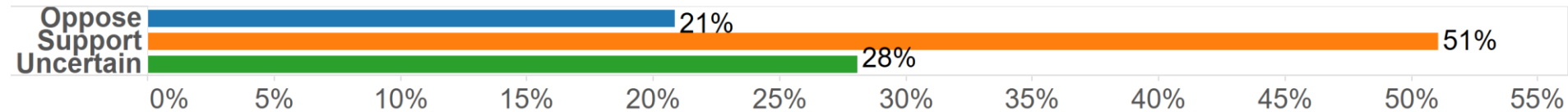

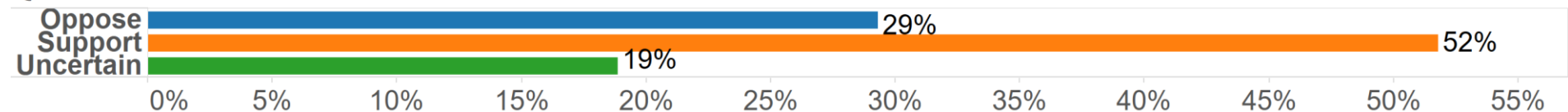

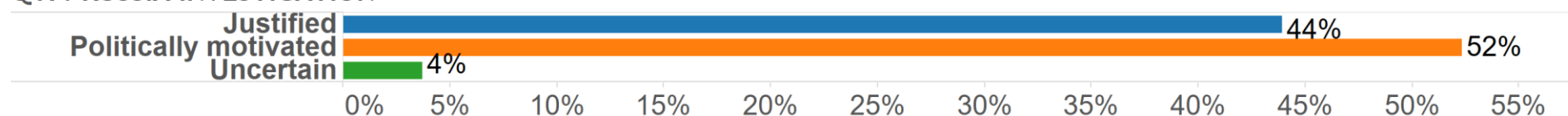

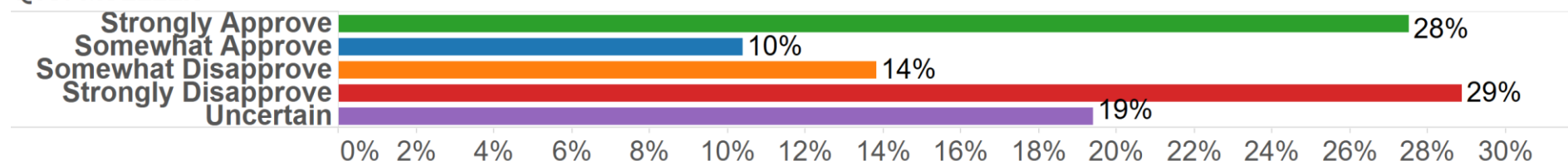

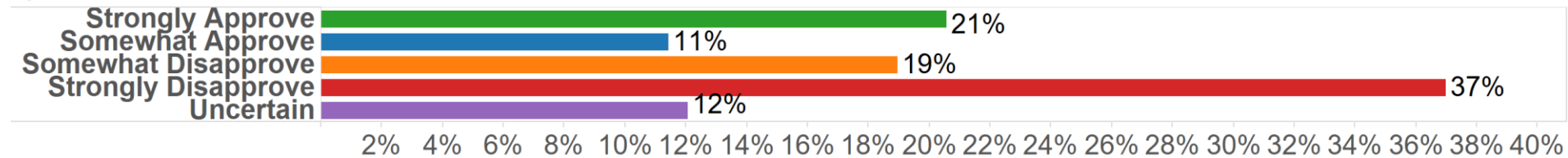

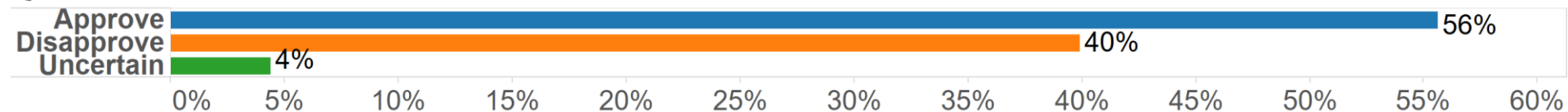

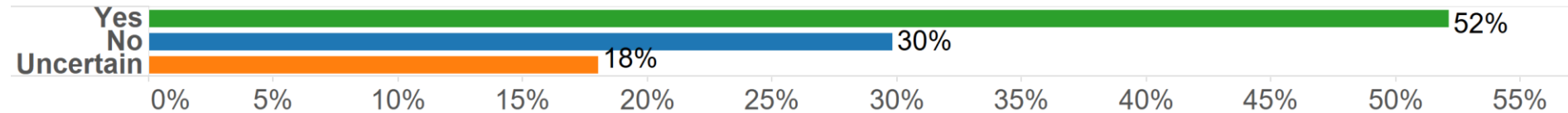

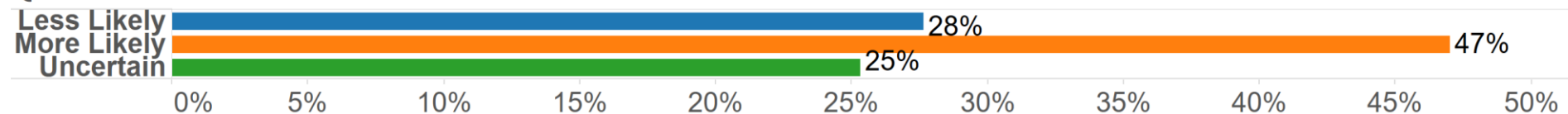

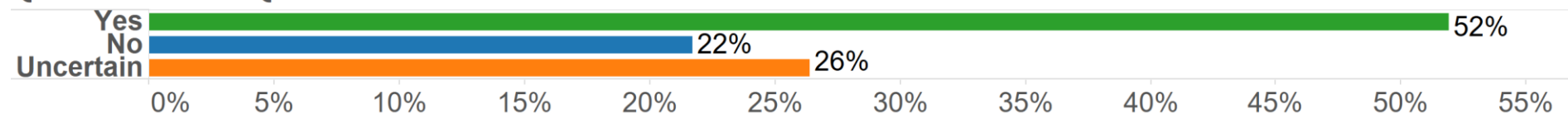

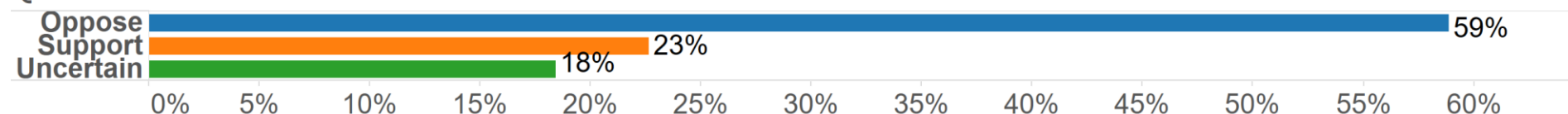

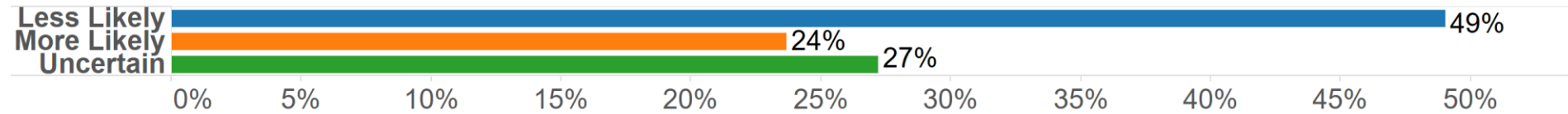

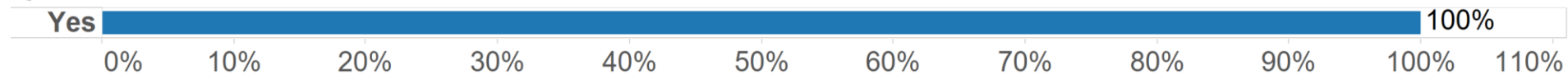

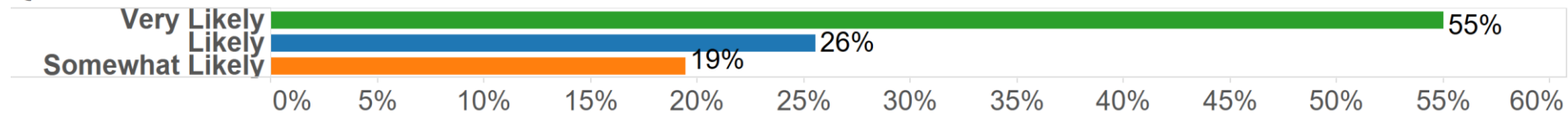

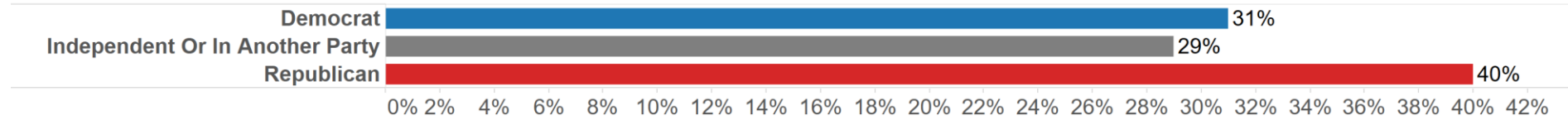
2) How likely are you to vote in the upcoming Tennessee Midterm Elections?

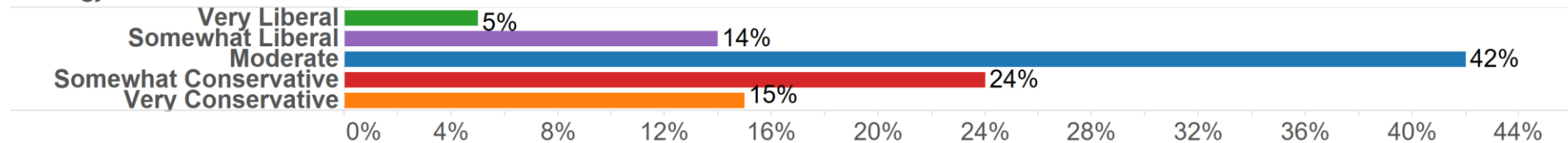

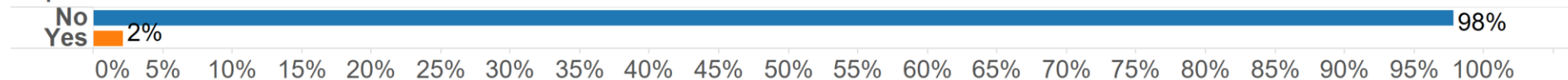
**27) What is your political ideology?**

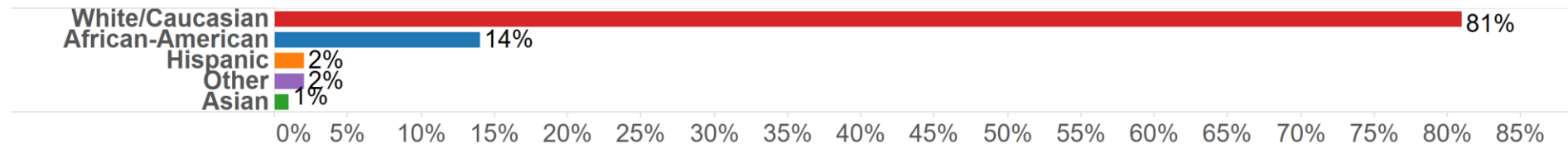
**28) Are you or is a member of your immediate family from a Latino, Hispanic or Spanish speaking background?**

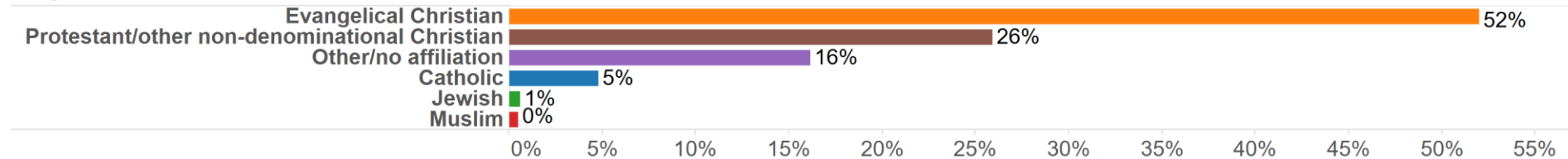

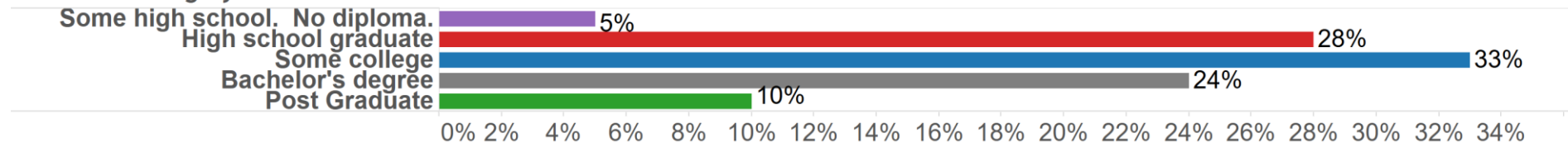

#### Religious affiliation



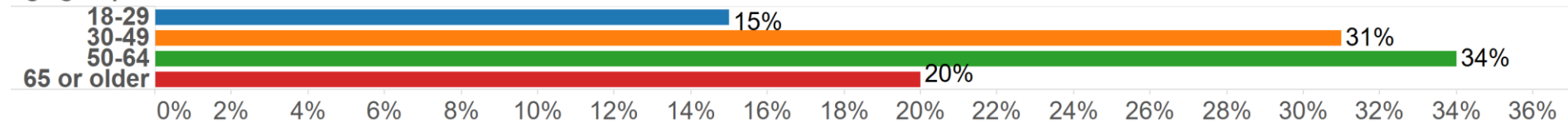
