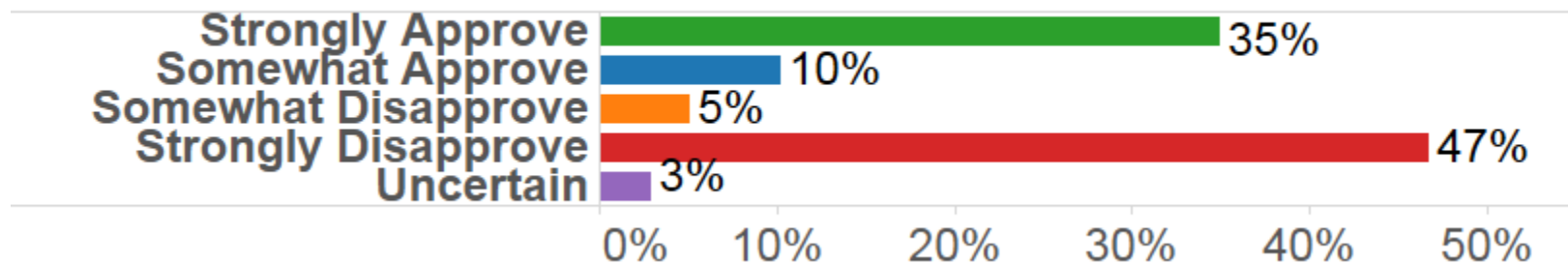

Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 882 registered, likely voters in Arizona. The poll was conducted from September 5th through the 7th, with a margin of error of $\pm 3.3\%$. The totals may not round to 100% because of rounding. The survey was conducted using interactive voice responses and an online panel of cell phone users. The results are weighted by voting demographics. The poll was paid for by Gravis Marketing.

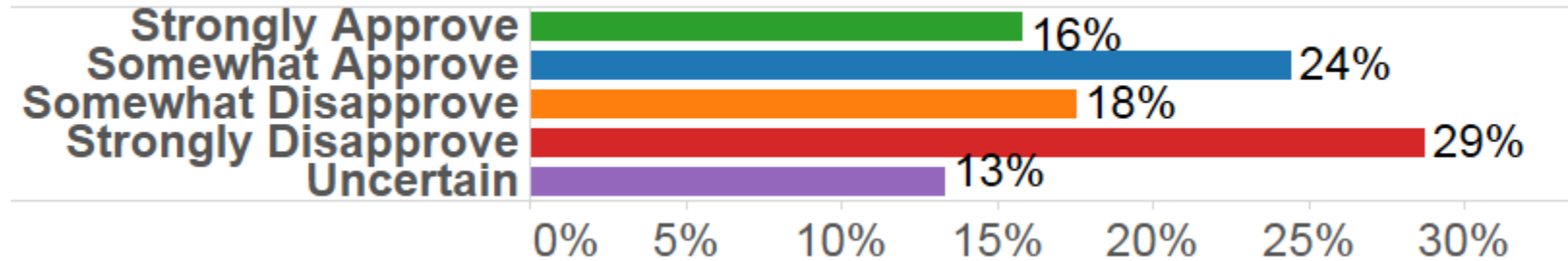

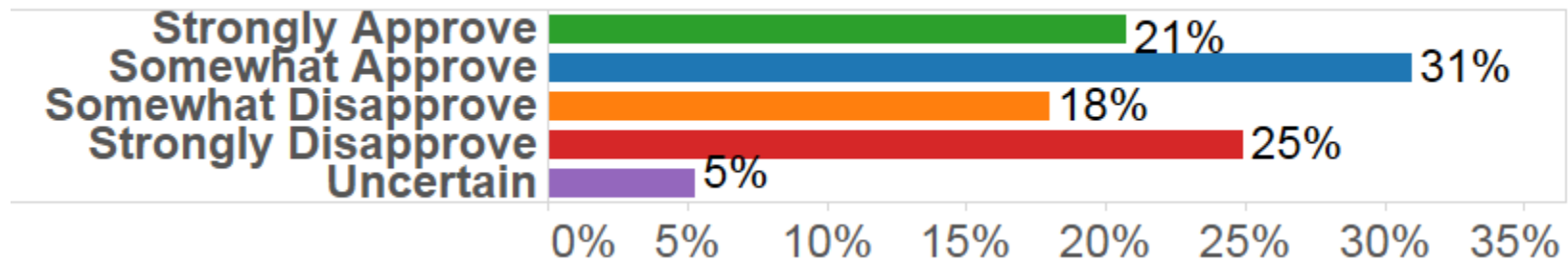

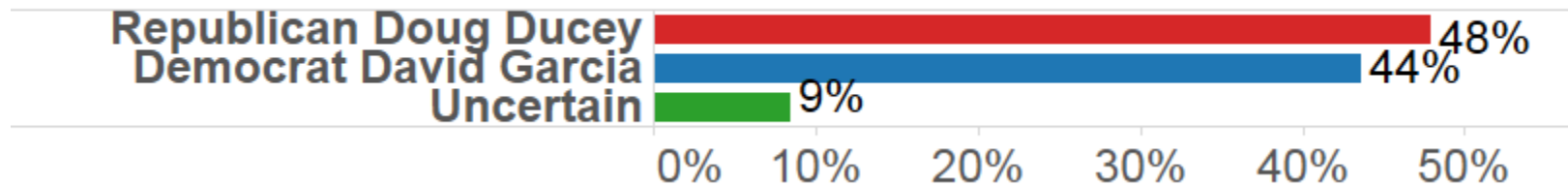

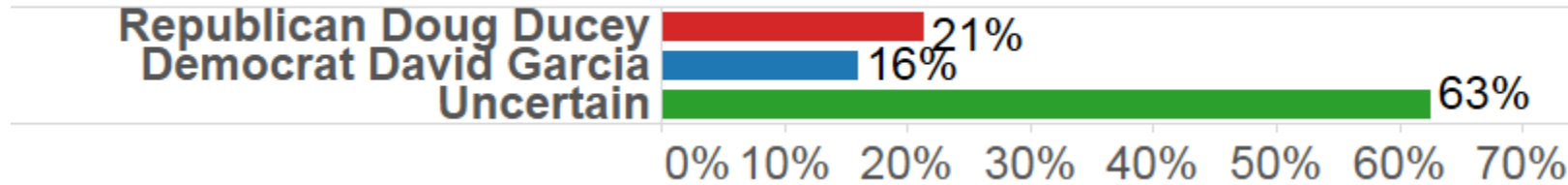

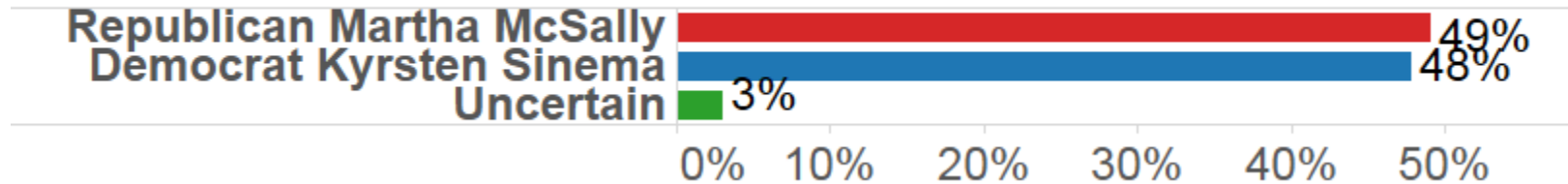

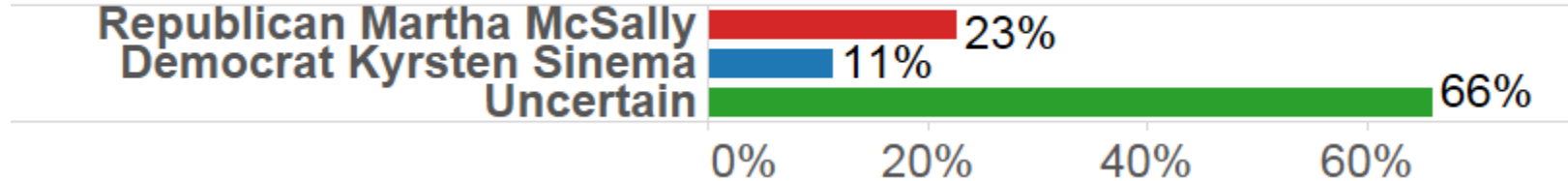

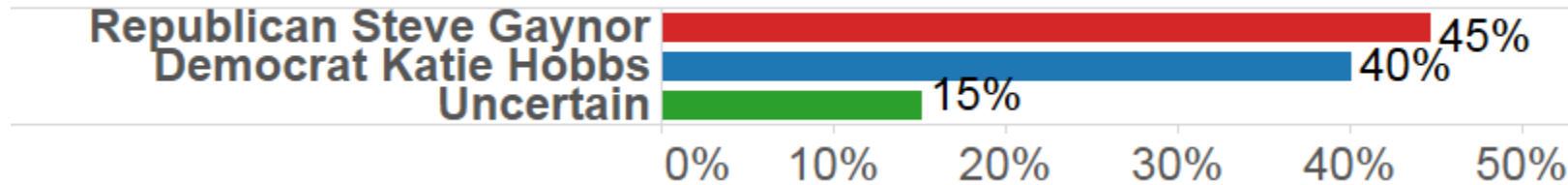

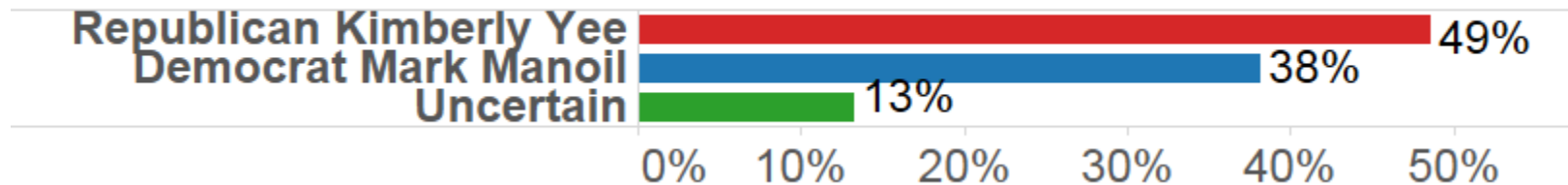

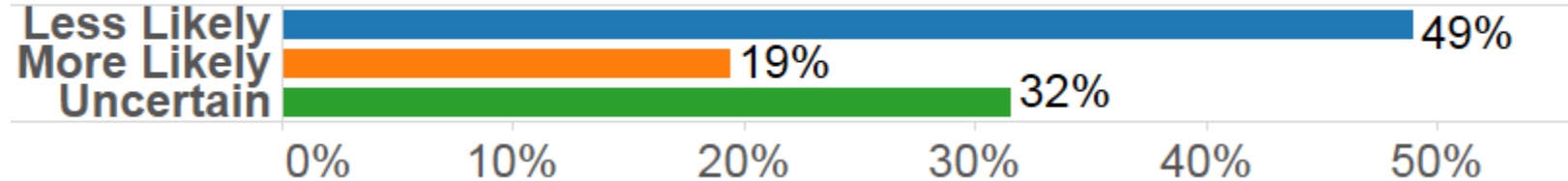

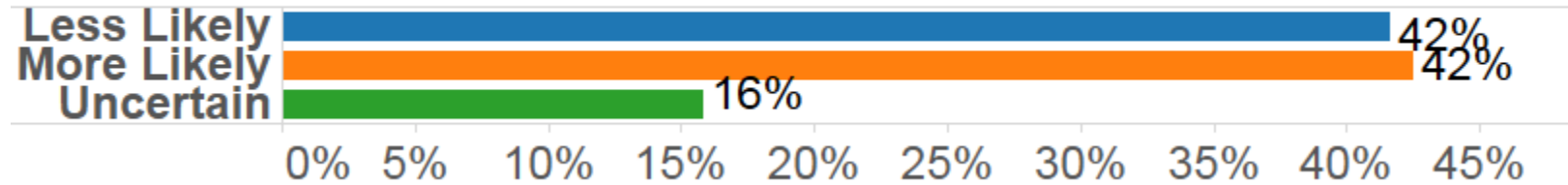

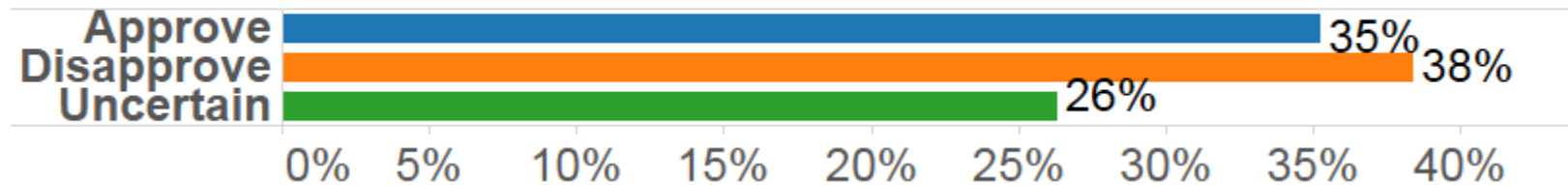

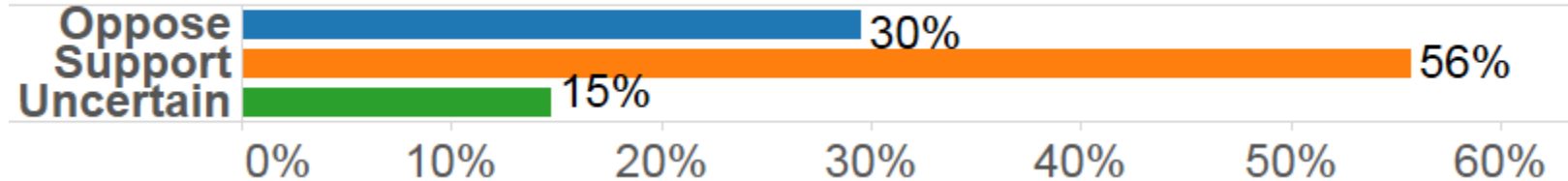

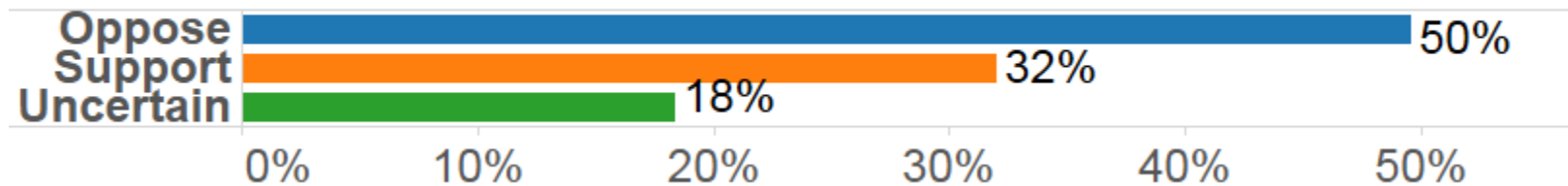

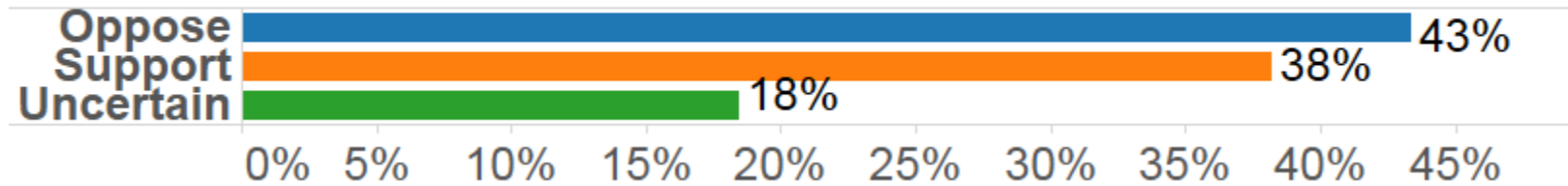

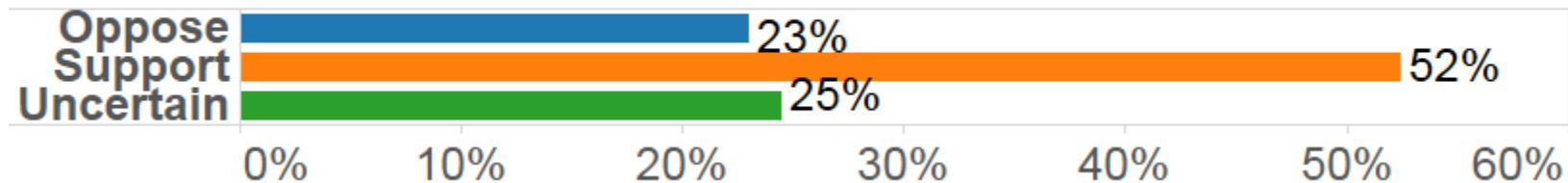

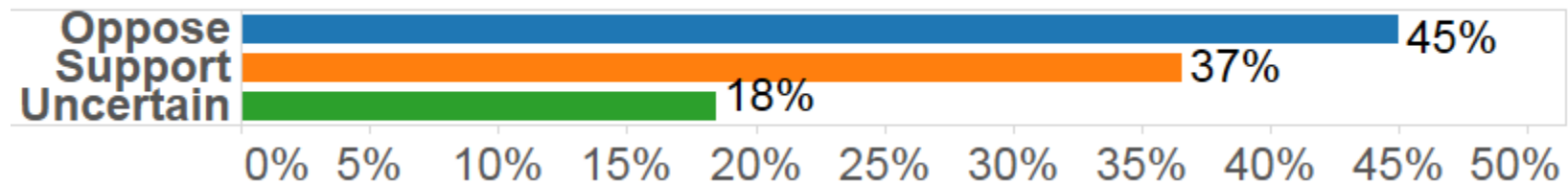

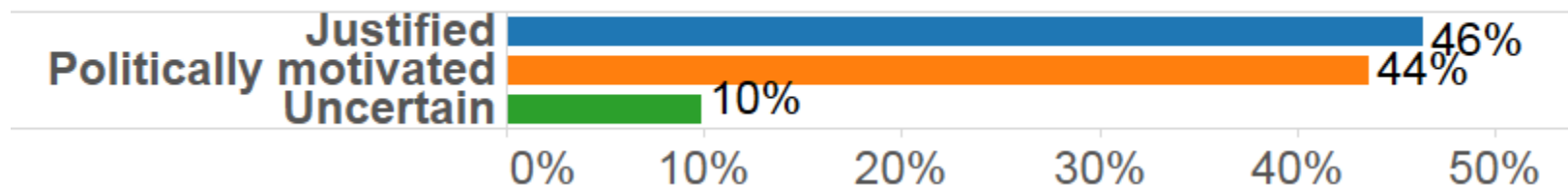

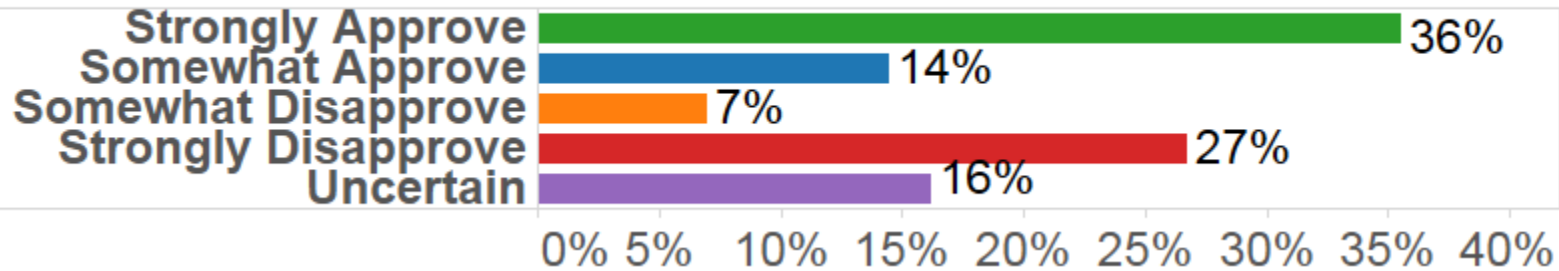

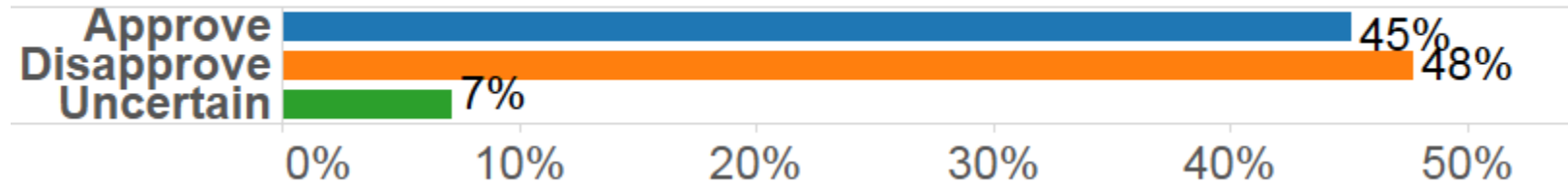

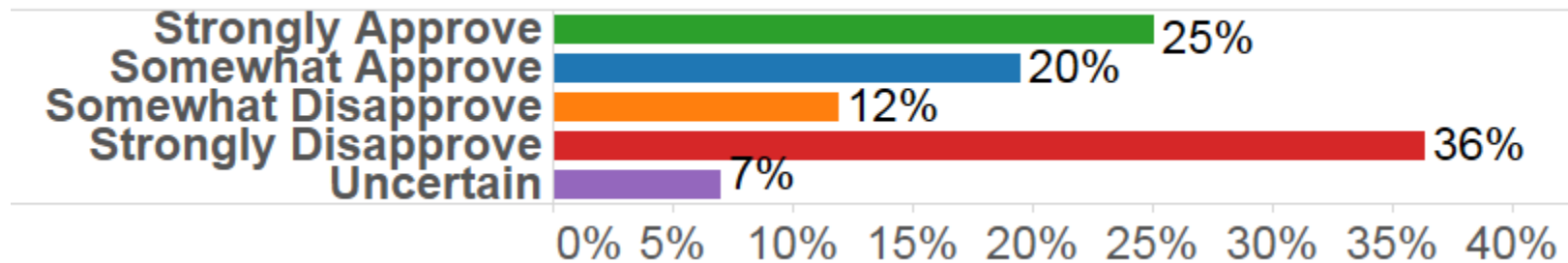

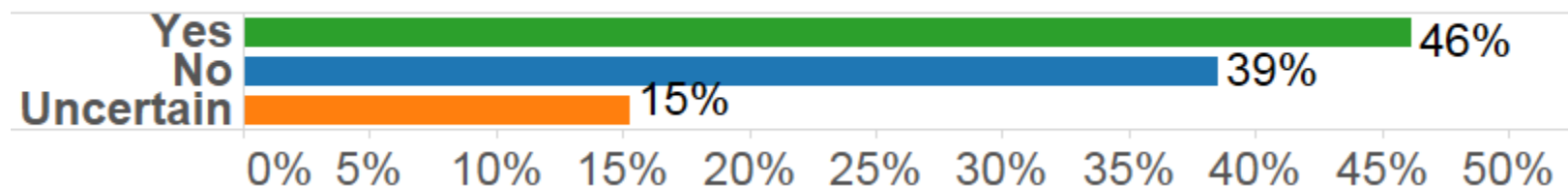

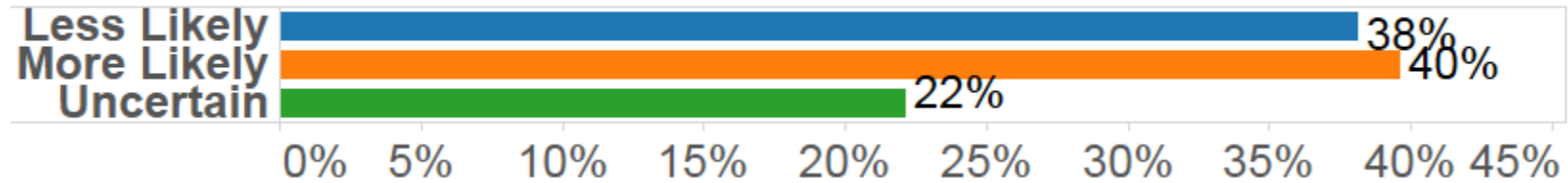

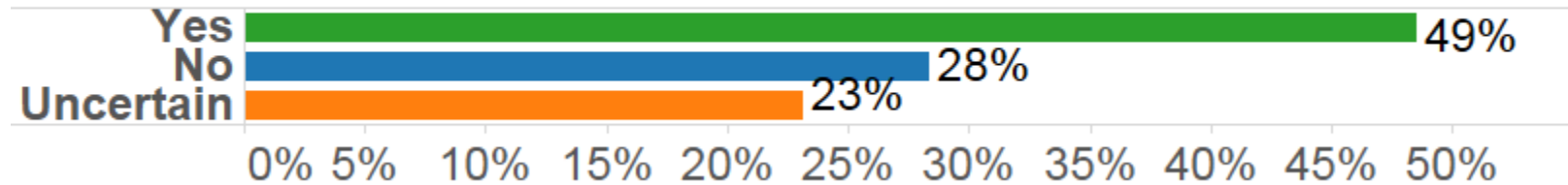

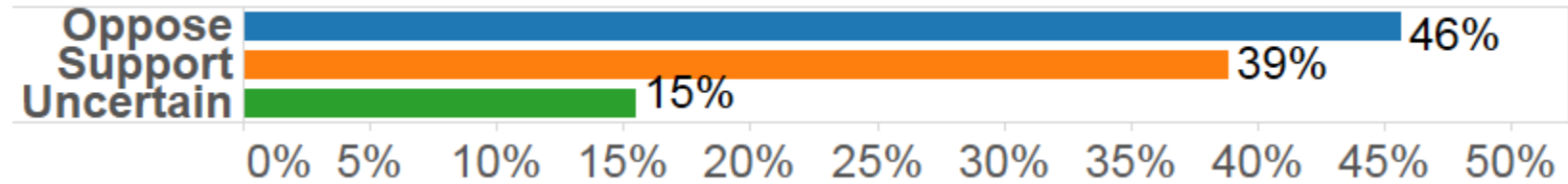

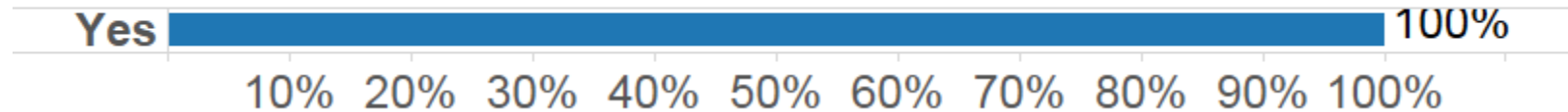

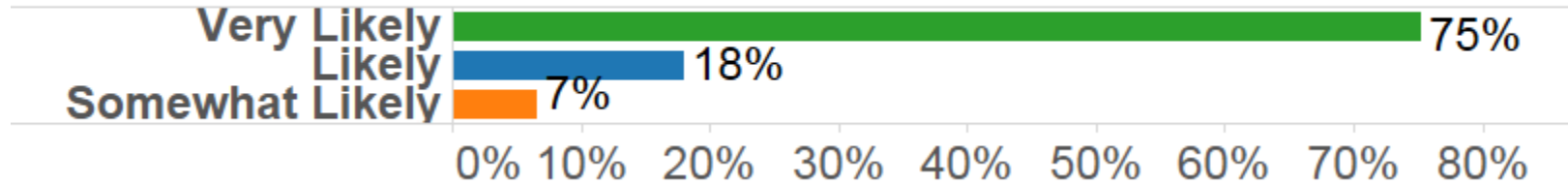

Q1: REGISTERED



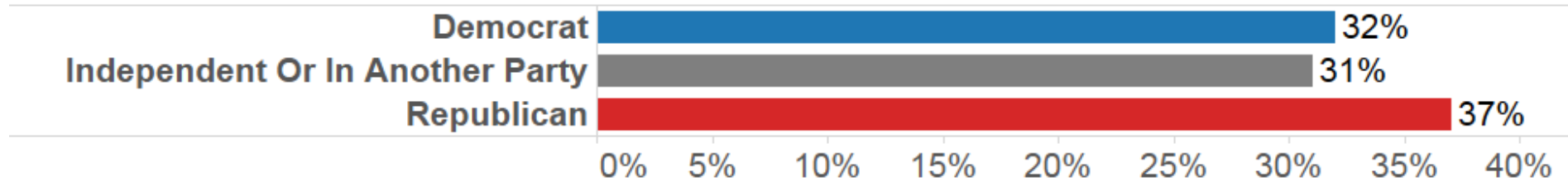
2) How likely are you to vote in the upcoming Arizona General Election in November?

Q2: LIKELIHOOD



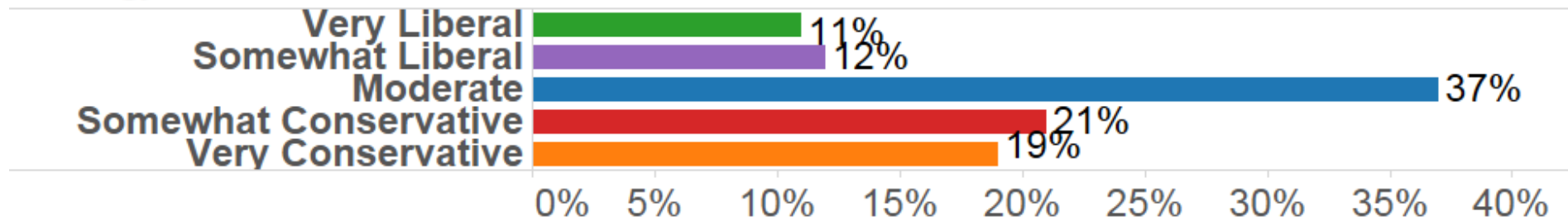

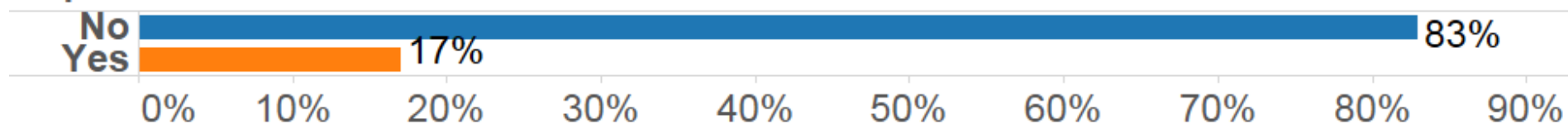

Ideology



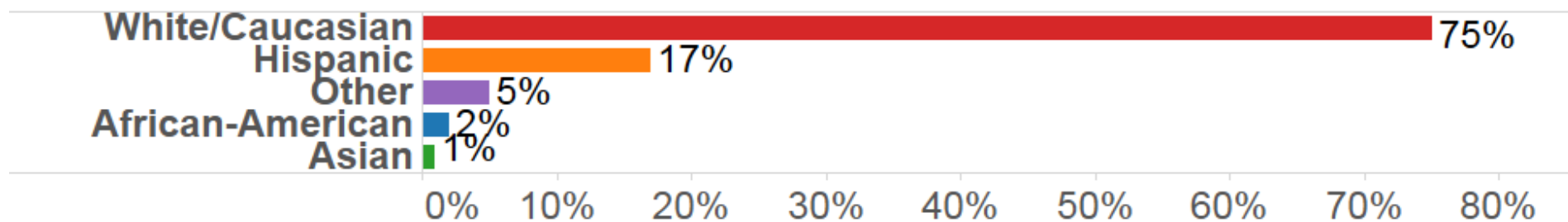
30) Are you or is a member of your immediate family from a Latino, Hispanic or Spanish speaking background?

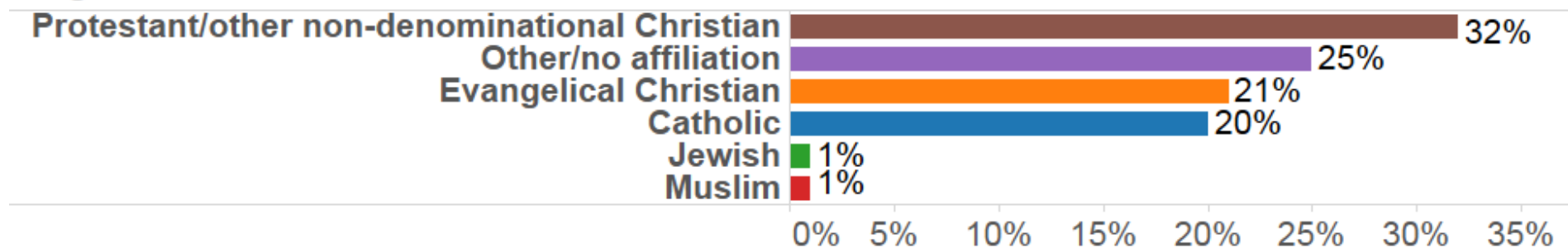

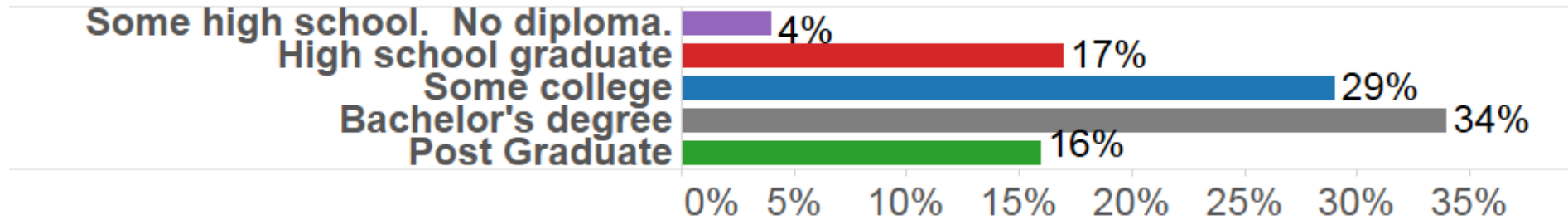
32) Which of the following best represents your religious affiliation?

Religious affiliation



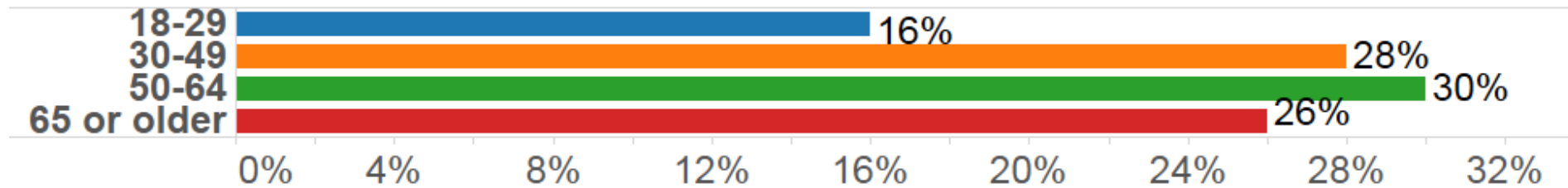
33) What is the highest level of education have you completed?
